# NATIONAL MARITIME DAY CELEBRATION ||||||||||||||

AMET University celebrated the National Maritime Day on 5th April 2015 by conducting several competitions and events as a mark of celebrations. Capt.J.S.Uppal, Principal Officer, Mercantile Marine Department, Chennai participated as Chief Guest of this function and delivered the Maritime Day address. In his address, he has stated that he was very happy to see the young seafarers of the Indian Maritime Industry participate in the events. He emphasized on the safety aspects in the shipping Industry



without which safety and environmental improvements cannot be achieved. He also spoke about the revival of the shipping industry globally and stated that, as per BIMCO that there would be total of 19,000 vacancies for maritime officers by the end of this year and around 22,000 by the end of 2018. Therefore, the demand for Indian Officers would go up, because of the tolerance, competency, and the maritime education and training given to them.

The President of the AMET University, Dr.J.Ramachandran in his presidential address pointed out that the current maritime education and training scenario in India are in the uprising in the shipping industry globally. He emphasized on the increasing demands of the merchant navy officers in the near future and the increase in the job opportunities in the maritime sector and the various shipping companied coming for recruitment in the University.

Col.Dr.G.Thiruvasagam, the Vice-Chancellor of the University in his speech opined that when we celebrate the National Maritime Day on 5th April, we must also take into nation's remembrance of the great patriot and freedom fighter of Tamil Nadu, V.O.Chidambaram Pillai. It was he who launched the first indigenous Indian Shipping Enterprise, named as Swadeshi Steam Navigation Company and commenced the regular voyage between Tuticorin and Colombo, way back on 12th November 1906 and well ahead of the launching of SS Loyalty of M/s Scindia Steam Navigation Co. Ltd.

He further stated that 80 to 90 percent of the maritime accidents are taking place due to human error. Hence, it is critical that seafarers are to be well educated and trained, able to follow orders, to manage risks, solve the problems and must be psychologically and emotionally fit to ensure safe, secure, clean and efficient operations for safety of



like at sea. Recognizing the significance of highly competent human resources at sea, Maritime Education and Training should be enhanced in terms of facilities and equipment, curriculum design, learning methodologies, quality of instructions and in all aspects of ensuring a pool of high qualified and competent marine officers and engineers to man the world fleet.

Mr.S.Karikalan, Trustee of the University emphasized the need for the quality in maritime education and training in

India. He further remarked that the training given to the cadets of the AMET University are all followed with the guidelines given by the Directorate General of Shipping and STCW -78 convention as amended.

During the celebrations, Cadet Rahul Prabhu of B.E. Marine Engineering was felicitated for his selection to represent India in the proposed International Organization of Maritime Universities (IOMU) – Students Forum 2015, which will be held from 18th to 24th July 2015 at Tokyo, Japan.
