Student Satisfaction Survey:

Student Satisfaction Survey has been conducted for overall Institutional performance. The IQAC has conducted the Student Satisfactory Survey online by forming a specific questionnaire. The students were sent with links for giving their feedback. The responses were collected and analysed. Overall, 64.5% students expressed their satisfaction to all the criteria while 30% of students have expressed average level of satisfaction. Altogether 94.5% satisfactory feedback has been obtained which is well above required satisfaction. However, the analysis indicated following focal points to be considered for improvement. The University has taken the suggestions and improvised the same. The focal points, suggestions proposed and action taken are summarized and uploaded in the University website.






1(a). How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 955 responses




1(b). How much of the syllabus was covered in the online classes? 955 responses



1(c). What is the overall coverage of the syllabus? 955 responses




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?956 responses




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 956 responses




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.




7. The University takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 956 responses




8. The teaching and mentoring process in the University facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.


9. The University provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.


11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.


10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.


12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.


13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




15. The University makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them 956 responses




16. The University / teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.




17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.



18. Efforts are made by the University / teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
