### Additional Information's / Instructions:

- **♦** The Managers of the Teams should pay **Rs.2,500/- per team as officiating charges** to the Organizing Secretary before the commencement of each Match.
- The Manager of the team should produce Annual Subscription fees Receipt & AIU Registration Fees Receipt.
- At the time of arrival, all the team managers of participating Universities must submit the relevant documents as per the AIU guidelines at AMET University Match Registration Counter.
- Recent Players Identity Cards & a copy of AIU- Subscription Fees Paid Receipt and Registration Fees Paid online copy (AIU- Introduced 2022-23) should be handed over to the Organizing Secretary at the time of Registration board.







- In support of the Eligibility details of the students, taking part in the All India Inter Zonal Universities Chess (Men) Championship 2022-2023, Xerox copies of their 10<sup>th</sup> class (SSLC) and / 12<sup>th</sup> equivalent pass & provisional certificate of the degree (in case of P.G students) certificates & Aadhar Card attested by the director of physical education concerned must be submitted to the organizing secretary.
- ▶ Protest against any other nature in connection with conduct of sporting competitions shall be in writing and must reach the organizing secretary along with protest fee Rs.1500/- only within "Two Hours" of the conclusion of the concerned matches for consideration of the "Official of Appeal" for an appropriate necessary action, then and there / on the spot, in this regard.
- The Organizing Secretary reserves the right to make changes in the program and venue, if necessary, which shall be final and binding on the participant teams
- **★** The Teams should report in the grounds at least thirty minutes prior to the commencement of their matches
