Accommodation

Teams will be provided free unfurnished room for accommodation inside the University campus. 24 hours prior to the commencement of their match and the teams have to vacate the accommodation after the completion of their matches.

- Each team has to pay Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) as Caution deposit, which shall be refunded at the time of departure of the team adjusting the cost of the damages, if any.
- Accommodation will be provided to the participating students, Managers and Coaches.
- Teams are requested to bring their own Locks & Keys for their safety.

Team Manager's Meeting

The meeting of all the Team Managers of participating teams will be held on 06-01-2022 at 5:00.p.m. in Shri Janakiraman Auditorium at AMET University. Four copies of the Eligibility Performa of the players duly filled in and signed by the Registrar / Director of Physical Education of the participating University along with Recent Players Identity cards & a copy of Subscription receipt obtained from AIU New Delhi should be handed over to the organizing secretary at the time of registration.

Important Note

- As per the amendments / Modifications in the existing eligibility rules for participation of the students in National University Games from the Year 2021-22, the participating Universities should submit the attested photocopies of Diploma Certificate or 10 and +2 in case of the player is studying in Under Graduate (UG) Course And That Of Diploma Certificate or 10, +2 and Graduation if the Player is studying in post Graduate course, to the organizing University duly attested by the Director of Physical Education of the Concerned universities.
- All the Universities should bring their University Flag for attending March-past Compulsory on 7th December 2021@7am in our Parade ground during Inauguration at University Campus.
- Covid Vaccination certificate (Double Dose) is Mandatory for the participations including Coach and Manager. Certificate should be submitted at the time of Registration.
- If Participants with Single Dose Vaccination has to produce RTPCR Test report not later than 72 hrs.(3 days)

Officiating Charges

The Managers of every team should pay Rs.1500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred Only) per match as officiating charges and Rs.450/- (Rupees Four Hundred and Fifty Only) as ball Charges to the organizing Secretary / court In-Charge before the commencement of their match.

Competition Rules

- Matches will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI) as adapted by AIU, New Delhi.
- Morning Session matches starts at 7.00am and Afternoon Session matches starts at 2.00pm
- The teams are requested to follow the match schedule strictly and should report at least half-an-hour before the commencement of the matches.
- The decision of the tournament committee on all matters relating to the tournament shall be final and binding.
- The organizing secretary reserves the right to make changes of the venue, date and time of the matches, if necessary
- Protest against any other nature in connection with conduct of sporting competitions shall be in writing and must reach the organizing secretary along with protest fee Rs.1500/- only with "Two Hours" of the conclusion of the concerned matches for consideration of the "jury of Appeal" for an appropriate necessary action, then and there / on the spot, in this regard.

General

- The Team Managers and Players are requested to co-operate with the organizing secretary for the smooth conduct of the tournament.
- Team Managers are totally responsible for their players to maintain discipline during competition & stay.
- The climate at Chennai during the competition will be slightly cold with Sea Breeze

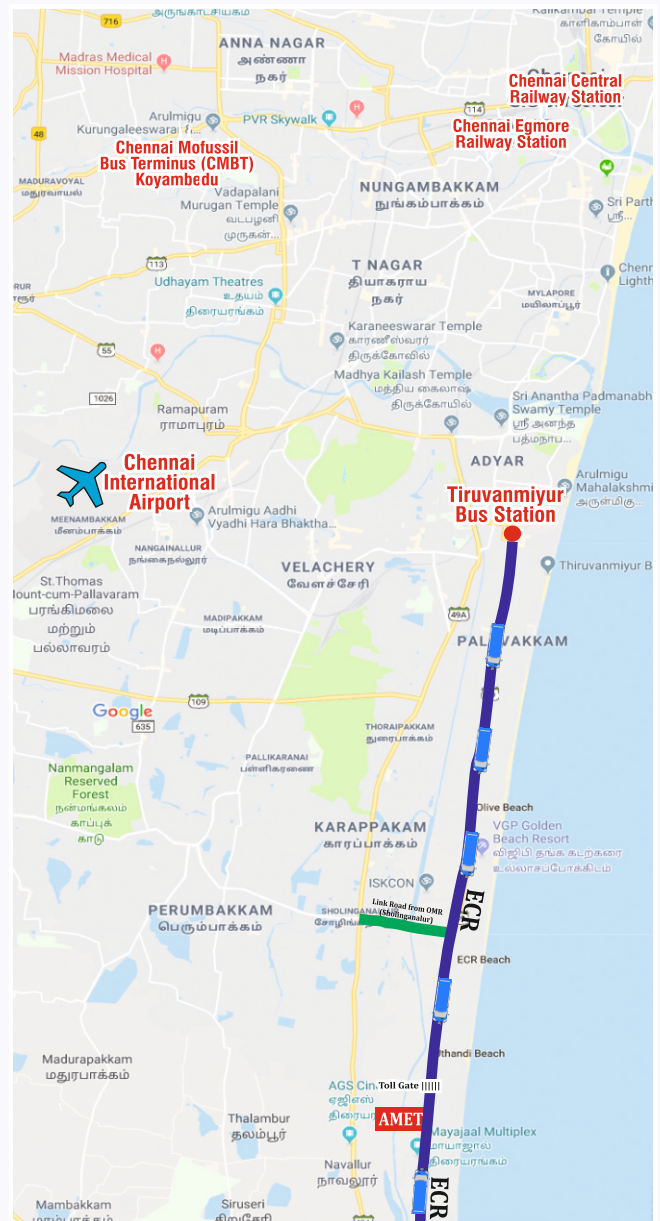
