The overall objective goal of this programme is:

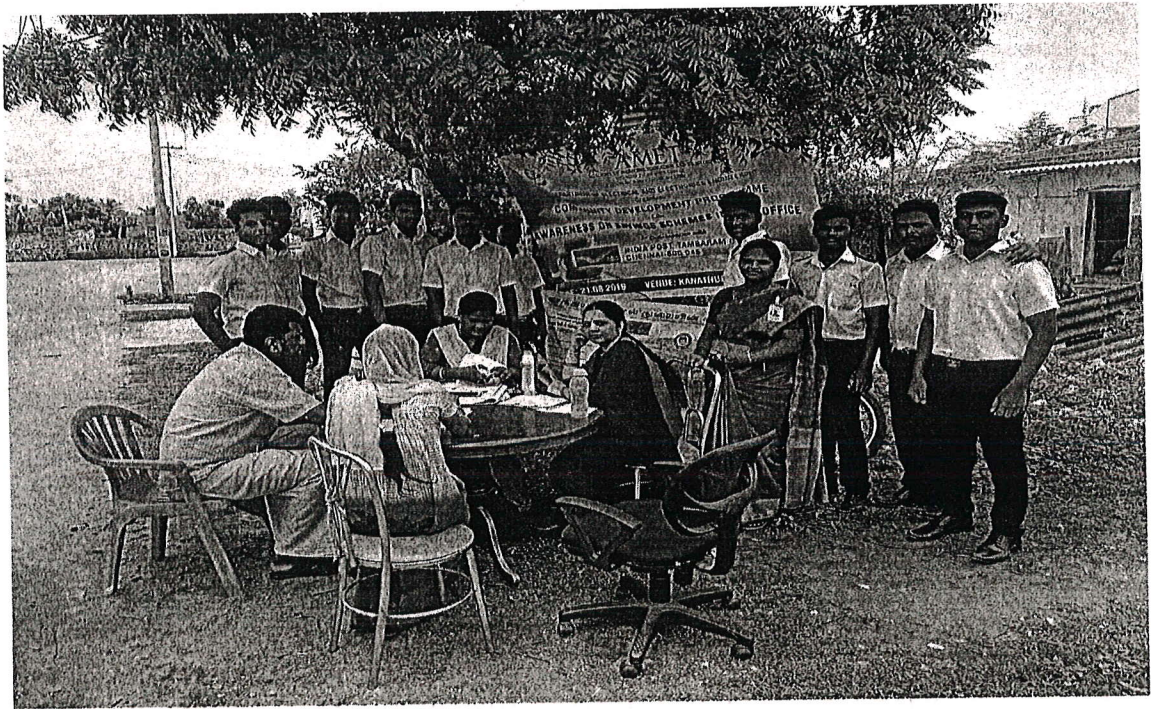
1. To “Create awareness on Savings Schemes in Post office and to improve the quality of life of rural population.

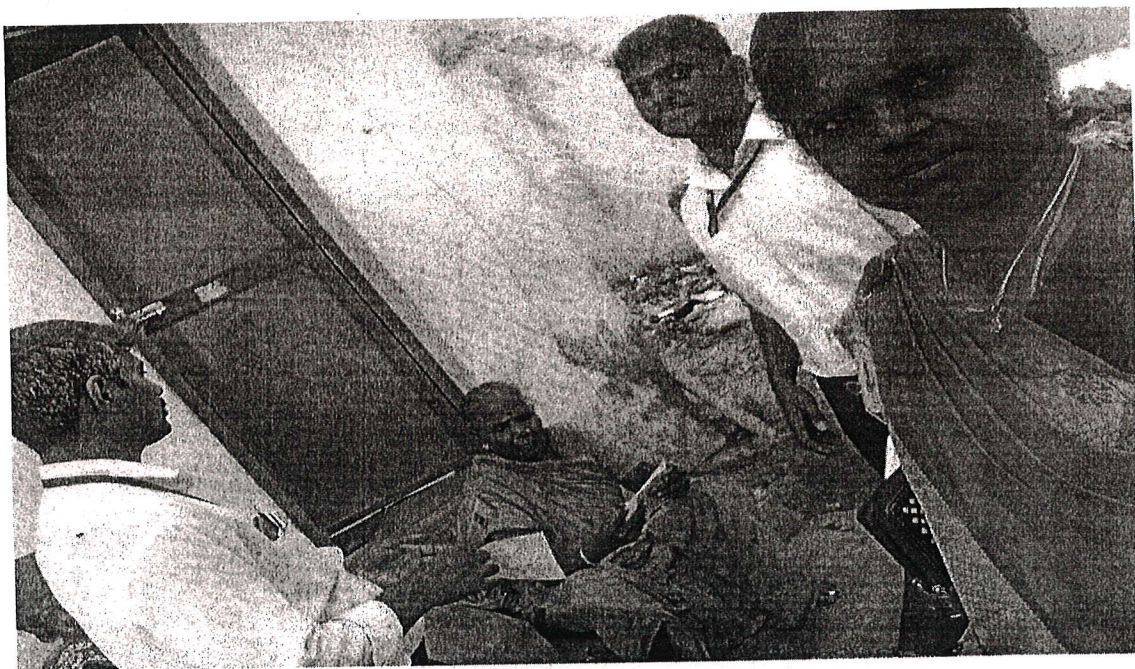


**Figure1. Account opening by Kanathur people**

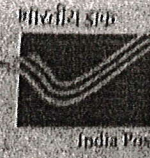

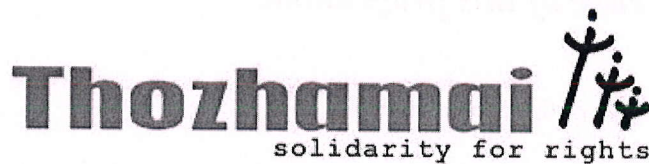

### **About Organ donation:**

**Tamil Nadu**, for the fifth consecutive year, received an award from the National Organ and Tissue Transplant Organization (NOTTO) for high number of organ donors and also for maintaining maximum utilization of organs.

Organ Donation Day is observed every year on 13<sup>th</sup> of August. Due to lack of awareness, there are myths and fears in peoples' mind about organ donation. The aim of this awareness is to motivate normal human beings to pledge to donate organs after death, and to spread awareness about the importance of organ donation.

Organ Donation is donating a donor's organs like heart, liver, kidneys, intestines, lungs, and pancreas, after the donor dies, for the purpose of transplanting them into another person who is in need of an organ

According to a survey In India every year about:

500,000 people die because of non-availability of organs, 200,000 people die due to liver disease, and 50,000 people die because of heart disease. Moreover, 150,000 people await a kidney transplant but only 5,000 get among them.

The organ donor can play a big role in saving others' life. The organ of the donor can be transplanted to the patient who needs it urgently.

### **Facts about Organ Donation**

- Anybody can be an organ donor irrespective of their age, caste, religion, community etc
- There is no defined age for donating organs. The decision to donate organs is based on strict medical criteria, not age.
- Tissues such as cornea, heart valves, skin, and bone can be donated in case of natural death but vital organs such as heart, liver, kidneys, intestines, lungs, and pancreas can be donated only in the case of 'brain death'.
- Organs such as the heart, pancreas, liver, kidneys and lungs can be transplanted to those recipients whose organs are failing because it allows many recipients to return to a normal lifestyle.
- Anyone younger than age 18 needs to have the agreement of a parent or guardian to be a donor.

Having a serious condition like actively spreading cancer, HIV, diabetes, kidney disease, or heart disease can prevent you from donating as a living donor.






### Transplant Authority Of Tamil Nadu

Transplant Authority of Tamil Nadu is a registered society, was formed by G.O.396 dated 12.12.2014 under the Chairmanship of the Honorable Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu. The General Body consists of 21 members including the Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare and Hon'ble Minister of Finance. Transtan's entire functions are overseen by an Executive Committee which includes the Principal Secretary to Government of Tamil Nadu, Health & Family Welfare Department.

Functions of Transtan include the following : Streamlining all procedures related to Cadaver and Living Organ Transplantation, helping hospitals identify brain stem death and maintain, distributing organs in a transparent manner, maintaining a online waitlist registry, transmitting soft skills related to donor maintenance, helping hospitals in medical legal procedures, liaising with Police in providing Green Corridor for transporting organs, compile a state and regional database, liaising with neighboring States in organ sharing, liaising with the Govt of India on issues related to transplants.

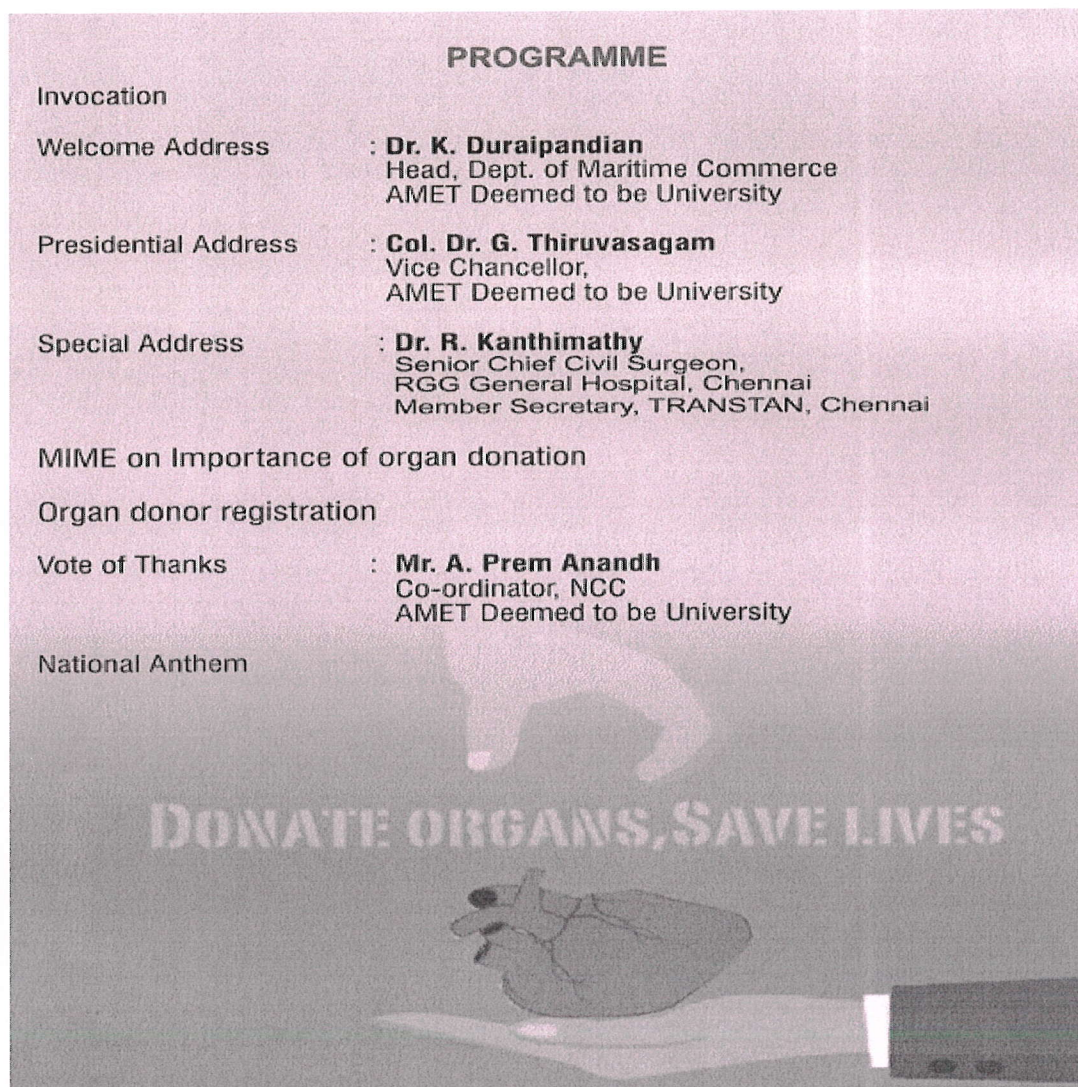
According to Transplant Authority of Tamil Nadu (TRANSTAN) data, the State has had 1,326 deceased donors from 2008 till date. A total of 7,783 organs, including 4,712 major organs such as heart, lungs, liver and kidneys, were donated.

As per the three-year data from November 2016 to October 2019, a total of 652 brain deaths were identified across the State. Of this, 431 brain deaths were converted to donations. The number of organs utilised during this period was 2,616. Official sources in the Health Department said from November 2018 to October 2019, the State had 128 deceased donors as against 140 last year.

From January to October this year, of the total 200 kidneys donated, 178 were utilised, recording 89% utilisation. Out of the 99 livers donated, 11% were declined owing to various conditions such as fatty liver, liver cirrhosis and elevated liver parameters.

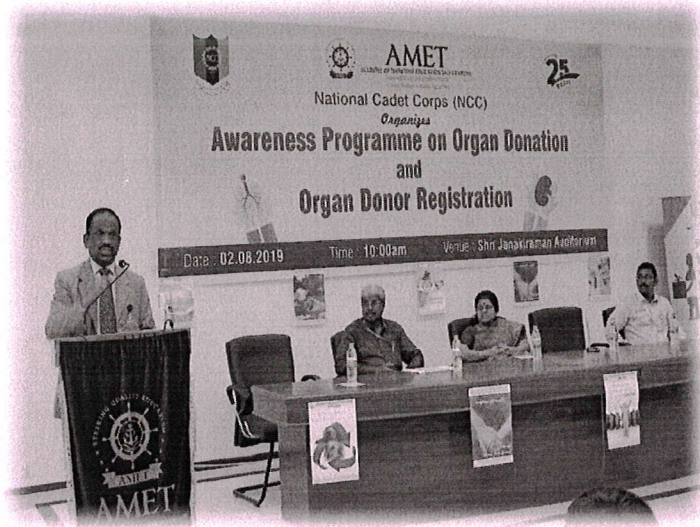
## Programme detail:



In this awareness and registration programme about 163 cadets/ Students were participated.

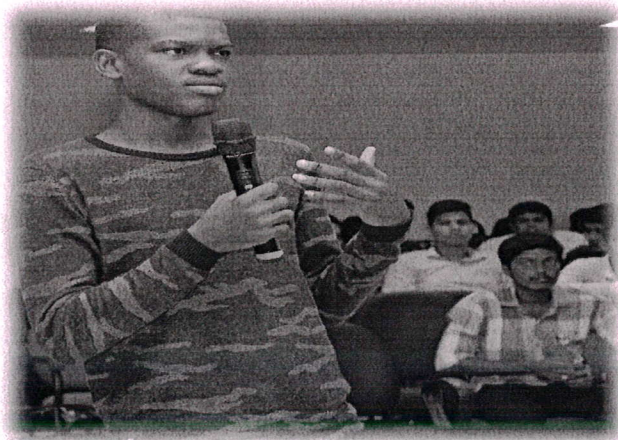
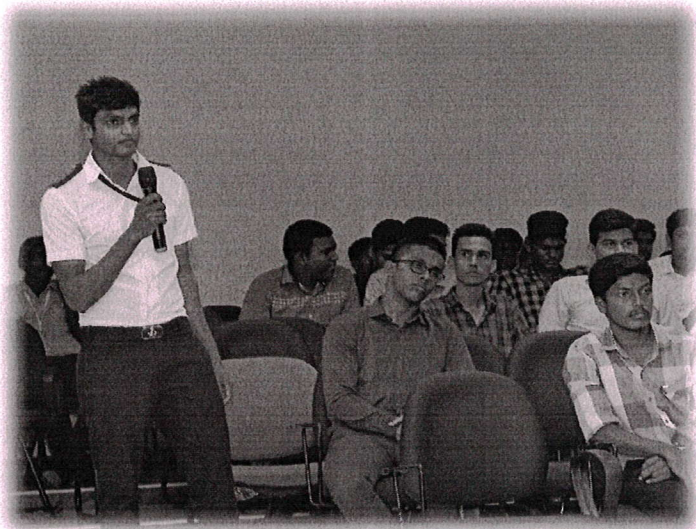

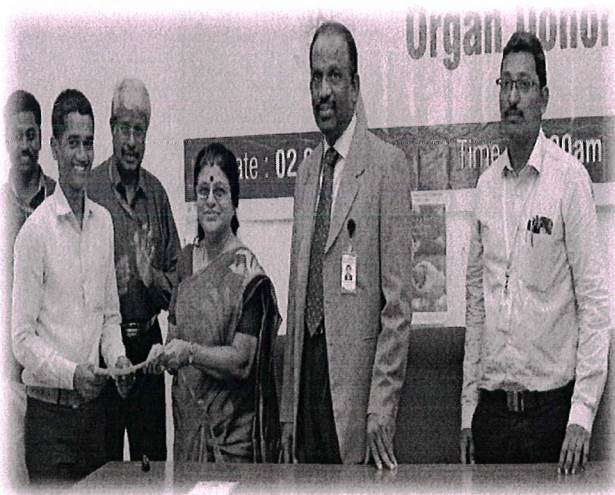
