#### **NOTIFICATION FOR**

### **ONLINE END SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS -JULY 2020**

The Office of the Controller of Examinations conducts Online End Semester Examinations (Regular/Arrear) – July 2020 for all the students (irrespective of the programme of study and year of study) in MYCAMU online portal, including for the passed out students irrespective of year of completion.

The Assessment Methodology of Online End Semester Examinations (Regular / Arrear) – July 2020 for all DGS and Non DGS Programmes is revised as follows.

#### 1. The Pattern of assessment:

Internal Assessment	40%	40%
Online End Semester Examination	60%	60%

#### 2. Online End Semester Examination:

The Online End Semester Examination will be conducted in the format of usual End Semester Examination question paper pattern for maximum of 100 marks (which will be converted into 60 marks) as follows.

Part A (Answer all: 10x2=20)

Part B (Compulsory: 1x10=10)

Part C (Answer all [either or type]: 5x14=70)

## **Duration: 4 Hours** Maximum Marks = 100 Marks

30 Minutes: To Login in MYCAMU Portal using the Unique ID & pass word and download the Question Paper

3 Hours: To write Answers

30 Minutes: To scan and upload the written answer scripts (maximum 20 pages) in MYCAMU Portal using the unique ID and Password

## 3. Practical Examinations:

#### For Non DGS Courses:

Awarding of marks for practical examinations of Non DGS programmes will be as follows.

Internal Assessment for 50 marks + Record / Observation Note Book for 50 marks = 100 marks

## For DGS Courses:

The practical examinations for DGS courses will be conducted as per the DGS guidelines.
