Annual Report of Office of the COE - 2019-2020

The Controller of Examinations collects the question papers for the End Semester Examinations set by the subject experts. It is followed by the preparation of the End Semester Examinations and the time table is published after recommended by the Examination committee and approved by the Vice Chancellor. The examinations are conducted as per the Examinations Time Table set by the Controller of Examinations. Subsequently, examiners are invited to evaluate the answer scripts and central valuation is conducted. After the completion of the evaluation process, the Passing Board Meeting is conducted for each department. The results are published within 10 days in the odd semester and 14 days in the even semester from the completion of the examinations and the same are published in the University website after getting the approval from the Vice Chancellor. After the publication of results, the students are given the opportunity to go for revaluation. They are also provided with a photocopy of their answer scripts evaluated for their reference.
