## IT integration and reforms in Examination Process

The office of the COE reformed the Examination Automation with the implementation of MYCAMU software portal which is suitable for both Offline and Online mode of examinations in the even semester of the academic year 2019 - 20. Using the CAMU of the COE conducts Examinations of both Internal and External End Semester Examinations.

The office of the COE has conducted the End Semester Examinations - July 2020 for the even semester of academic year 2019 - 20 through online using CAMU with 100% automation.

The procedures of the reformed Examination System with 100% automation for the conduct of Internal and External Examinations, Evaluation of answer scripts and publication of results are as follows.

### Examination Process:

#### Internal Examinations:

The total internal marks of 40 consists of 10 marks of Continuous Assessment Test 1 (CAT1), 10 marks of CAT2, 10 marks of Model Examinations, 5 marks of Assignment , home based internship and 5 marks of Attendance. The office of the COE conducts Model Examinations through online using CAMU and other Examinations of internals are being conducted by the faculty members for their handling courses.

All the internal examinations are conducted by following the Outcome Based Education.

Faculty members schedule in CAMU by assigning date and time for CAT1 and CAT2 examinations (Maximum of 50 marks) and then upload the question bank and question papers in the CAMU.

The students attend these internal examinations in CAMU (Students Portal) on the scheduled date and time. The students upload their soft copy of the answer scripts in CAMU portal within the fixed duration of the Examination in CAMU.

After evaluation of the answer scripts the faculty members upload the marks in CAMU. In case of multiple choice questions, the CAMU allots marks immediate after the submission of the examinations.

The faculty members enter marks of Assignment and marks of Attendance in CAMU portal. The office of the COE conducts Model Examinations for a maximum of 100 marks in the similar way of conducting CAT examinations.

CAMU converts 50 marks of CAT examination into 10 marks and 100 marks of Model Examinations into 10 marks. By combining all the internal components, CAMU generates the total maximum internal marks of 40.


#### **External Examinations:**

The students pay their examinations fees in the ERP/CAMU portal and also they download the Hall Ticket from ERP/CAMU to attend the End Semester Examinations.

The office of the COE conducts the End Semester Examinations as per Outcome Based Education with the recently implemented CAMU software, which is suitable for both Offline and Online modes.

The office of the COE has conducted the End Semester Examinations - July 2020 through online using CAMU with 100% automation.

The procedure to conduct the End Semester Examinations is same as that of the conduct the Model Examinations.

The office of COE schedules the examination and uploads the question banks and question papers in CAMU. The students download the question papers and upload the soft copy of the answer scripts in CAMU on the scheduled date of examination.

The examiners download the answer scripts for the evaluation from CAMU. The Examiners enter the marks in the foil card (excel sheet) after completion of the evaluation for the submission of marks to the office of the COE.

In case of offline examinations, the evaluated answer scripts with OMR home page and unique Bar Code are scanned to obtain the marks from the answer scripts. The marks are stored in the foil excel sheets.


Then these marks are transferred from foil excel sheet to CAMU.

As the End Semester Examinations are being conducted for a maximum of 100 marks, CAMU converts this 100 marks into 60 marks.

### **Evaluation Process:**

In case of Internal Examinations, the examiners download the answer scripts for the evaluation from CAMU. In case of online External Examinations, the office of the COE sends the downloaded answer scripts with foil excel sheet and question papers to the examiners and Heads of the departments through email. After completion of the evaluation, examiners enter the marks in the foil card (excel sheet) for the submission of marks to the office of the COE.

In case of offline examinations, the answer scripts and question papers are given to the examiners at the evaluation camp and the evaluated answer scripts with OMR home page and unique Bar Code are scanned to obtain the marks from the answer scripts. The marks are stored in the foil excel sheets with complete automation process.




**Publication of Result:**

CAMU combines both Internals and Externals into a total maximum of 100 marks and generates the result copy of all the courses department wise for the moderation process.

After the recommendation of moderation marks by the Board of Examinations and approval of the Vice Chancellor moderation process can be done in CAMU.

Once the moderation process is completed, CAMU generates the final gallery of the results of all the programs and the result can be made to view by the students in CAMU portal.
