#### DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The Department of Physical Education is functioning since 2001. The University has good sports facilities in the form of Basketball, Hi-tech Gym, Kabaddi, Volleyball Courts, Foot Ball Court, cricket Nets, Beach Volley ball, Snooker, Badminton and Hand ball court.

The University has a **standard swimming pool** with adequate safety measures. Swimming is compulsory for all DG Cadets in the University. Credits are awarded based on their performance.

The department of Physical education signed **MoU** with Tamil Nadu Physical Education and Sports University to encourage research activities, students training program, joint sports programme and sharing resources. Women students are encouraged to participate in sports. Sports Uniforms are provided to all students and also to those who represent the University in various events.

Students are admitted under sports quota and are provided free boarding and lodging facilities. University organizes national level, inter maritime Institution level competitions to promote Sports and Games among the students. Every year, the University organizes summer coaching camps in Swimming and Cricket for rural school students.

University organizes "AMET UNISPO" an Intra-collegiate sports event every year. Annual Sports Day is also organized.

#### **Gym and Fitness Centre:**

**The University provides three** separate Gym (Gym I=760 Sq.mtrs, Gym II =1441 Sq.mtrs and a Girls Gym = 89 Sq.mtrs). Equipment such as Treadmill, Elliptical Machine, Multi-Purpose Station Equipment, Cycling Machine, Leg Extensor Machine, Dumbbells,

- Schedules: 4 hrs per day were followed under the supervision of experienced Swimming Coaches.
- Survive class (STCW course): Weekly twice utilizes the pool.

### 2. Maintenance and carrying of Swimming pool:

- Three experienced Swimming Life Guards.
- Daily cleaning: Daily cleaning with Chlorine Dust cleaning machine in Circulation water.











