2 Reprography Services and Scanning Facilities

Photocopier is provided for users in the Central Library. Students can make photocopy of restricted number of pages (not exceeding 10% of total number of pages) in a book, articles from periodicals and newspapers and question papers. Library strictly follows copyright laws while providing this service. A scanner, photo copier cum printer and a printer are available in the library for the users.



Institutional Repository

The concept of preservation is dynamic due to the rapid growth of emerging technologies. For ease and quick retrieval of the preserved documents, DSpace Institutional Repository software has



been installed in AMET and the repository can be accessed through library web portal. DSpace is an open source software for building digital repositories. DSpace preserves and enables easy and open access to all types of digital content including text, images, moving images, mpegs and data sets. Born digital records can be catalogued and uploaded into the DSpace Repository to retrieve the right information at the right time to the user community. Paper format records can be digitized either by the digital camera or through a scanner, catalogued and uploaded in the DSpace for further retrieval as and when it is required. The digitization of the theses of doctoral studies, projects of engineering students, question papers, photographs, administrative and research valuable records are in process. 








Awareness of the events of AMET are displayed through plasma TV. Power point slides denoting the various resources available in the library are displayed to enlighten the user community.








E-BOOK CDs COVER








