### a) Safety and Security

In order to maintain Safety and Security to the Girls' students and Woman faculty, a committee has been constituted for Redress of Grievances. Our Internal Compliances committee stays alert all the time to prevent any sexual abuse to words students and female workers. We also focus on preventing this kind of harassments by using secret monitory services, which keep a keen eye on the entire campus.
