PLASTIC FREE CAMPUS AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

AMET launched an awareness campaign on full plastic ban in their University premises, on the 1st week of October, with regard to the full plastic ban policy enforced by the Government of Tamilnadu, the members of Student Council of AMET along with Mr. Sundar, Assistant Professor, Department of EEE Marine organized an awareness campaign in the university level amongst the students of AMET University.

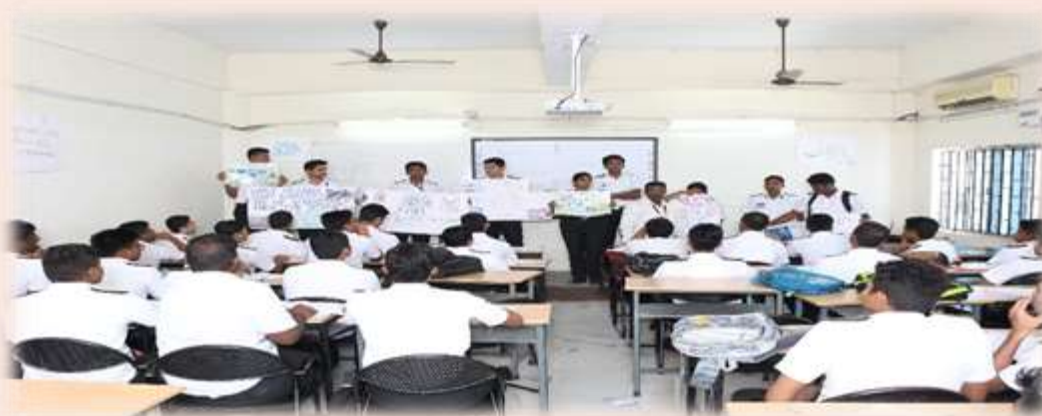

The Awareness programme was first started by explaining the harmful effects of plastics. Charts prepared by the students were used which contained the harms of daily usage plastics. Banners and placards containing the alternate means against usage of plastics were shown in the same, thereby ensuring that the students made use of this. Additionally, the law enforced by the government regarding total plastic ban was quoted, stating the exact fine amounts to be laid if found violating the law.

Furthermore, AMET had also installed a banner in the campus premise quoting the same in a brief way. The banners contained the list of things banned in the campus as well as the materials used alternatively instead of single use plastics. The awareness campaign saw a huge success with the students cooperating and compiling with the message of this campaign.

The pamphlets also contained the list of banned goods as listed under the regulation. In addition to that, the alternate materials that can be used instead of single use plastic were also listed to encourage the citizens to use that.

The rally then proceeded to kanathur fish market signal junction, where there was even more efficient campaigning with the faculties of AMET giving speeches. The students effectively conveyed the message of harmful effects of single usage plastics in daily life. To counteract it, alternate methods were suggested by the members of the rally.

The rally was successful with the public of the neighbourhood interacting with the AMET officials to help them suggest methods to control plastic usage in their neighbourhood. The rally continued until the stretch of Ragas hospital in the East Coast Road with the students then returning to the University.

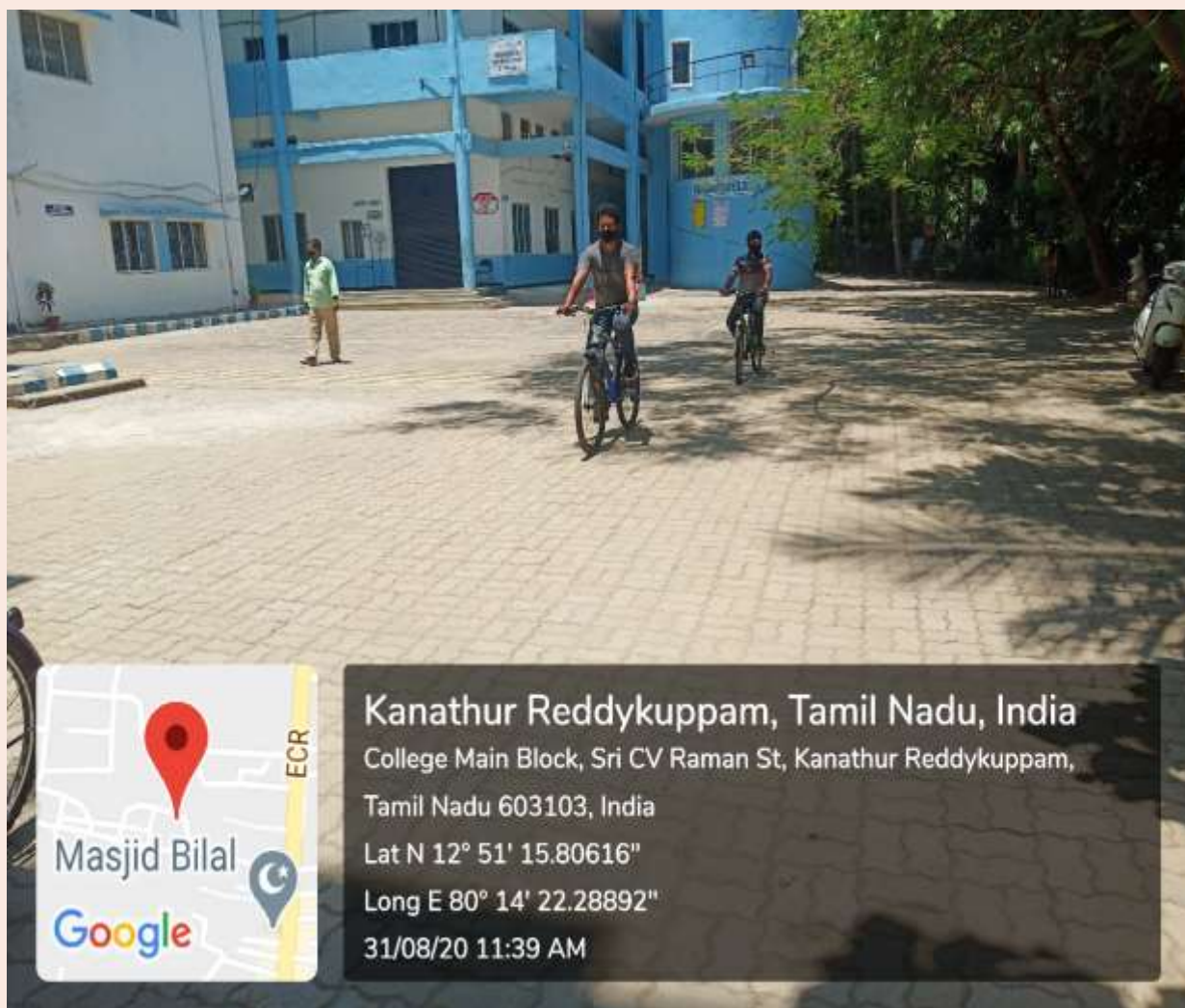


No vehicle day organized in campus

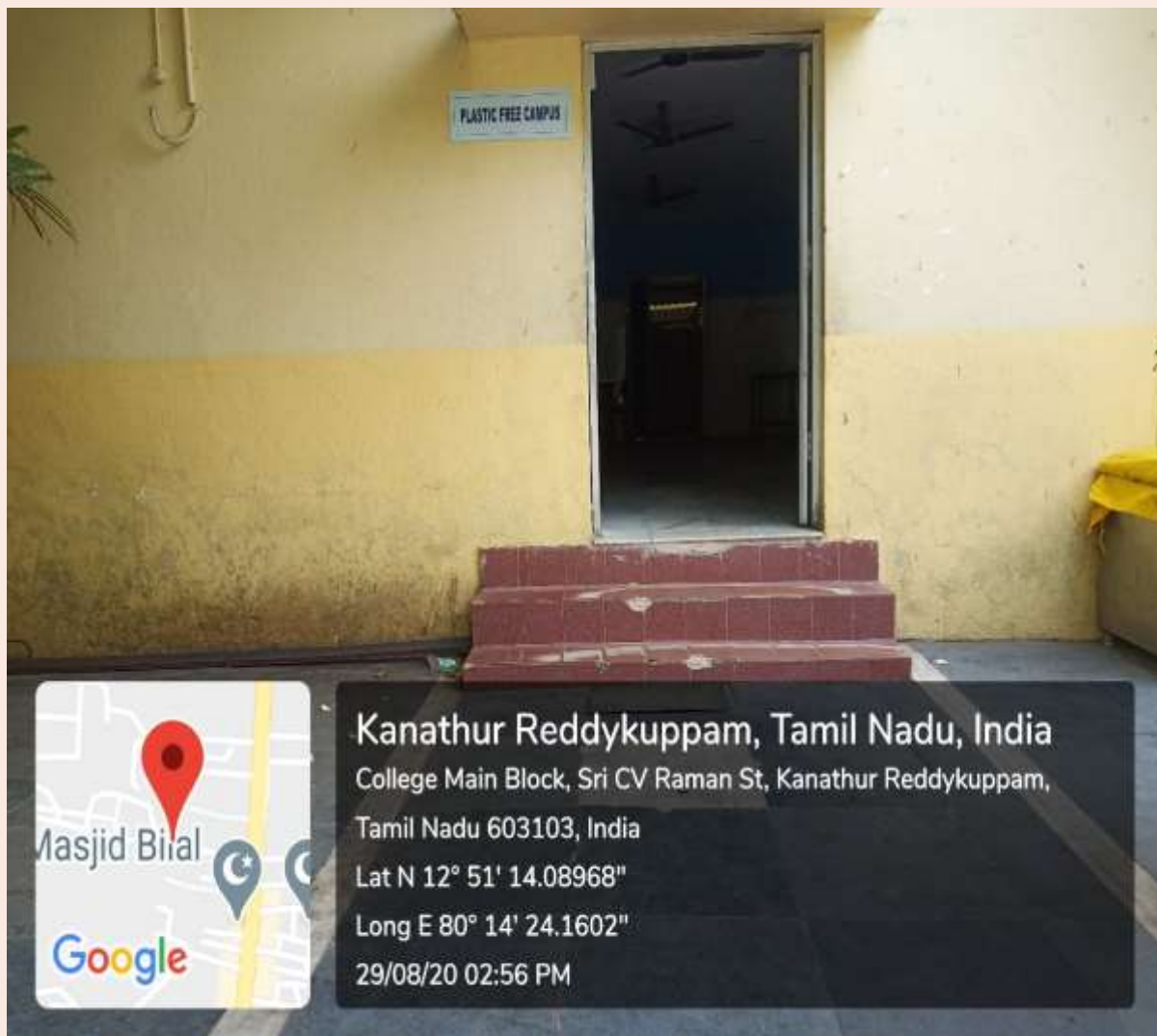
